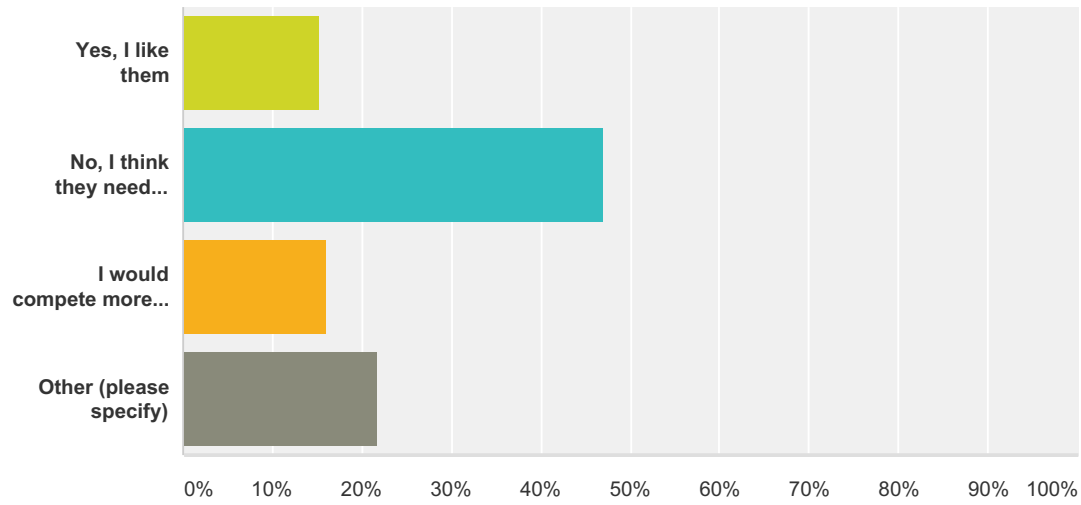


### Q9 What is your opinion of the current rules governing the Australian Rally Championship?
