
### Tuesday, July 23

After lunch we'll head for Stuttgart, taking in an afternoon city tour, before checking into our accommodation.

From Stuttgart, we travel to Heidelberg for a sightseeing tour of the ancient city. Some of the local highlights include Heidelberg University, founded in the 14th century, and the Gothic

Heiliggeistkirche church that towers over the cafe-lined Marktplatz, a town square in the Altstadt (Old Town). The red-sandstone ruins of Heidelberg Castle, a noted example of Renaissance architecture, stand on Königstuhl hill.
