

2024 Rally Finland Tour Itinerary

**Subject to change based on rally schedule*

Wednesday, July 31

4.00 pm Meet at Helsinki International Airport Bus terminal for transportation to your Accommodation in Himos.

7.00 pm Arrive at your accommodation and check-in.

Thursday, August 1

After a buffet breakfast at your accommodation, we travel to the WRC Shakedown to watch the world's best rally drivers in action.

In the afternoon we'll visit the Junior WRC service area to catch up with Australians Taylor Gill and Dan Brkic and look over their 2024 WRC challenger.



During this time at the service park, there is an optional

M-Sport World Rally Team service area visit (in place of visiting Gill/Brkic) at an additional cost.

Tonight we'll watch the opening stage of the rally, the famous Harju street stage in the heart of Jyvaskyla.

Friday, August 2

Breakfast at your accommodation before we head to watch the first full day of Rally Finland. Today we expect to see two or three stages of the world's best drivers in action.

Saturday, August 3

After you tackle yet another buffet breakfast, the group will travel to the second day of the event, typically the longest of the rally. Like on the opening day, we plan to see two or three stages of action.

Sunday, August 4

The final day of the rally action will see us up to watch two special stages after breakfast at our accommodation. At midday local time, we will see the rally-ending Power Stage close by to the podium (**pictured**) as drivers battle for extra championship points.

Monday, August 5

An early start for breakfast will be followed by the road trip to Helsinki Airport, with the group arriving at approximately 10.00 am.

Guests will then part ways and head home, or continue their pre-arranged European adventures.
